### **Articulation Agreement in Music programs**

This Agreement between Schenectady County Community College, Schenectady, NY ("SCCC") who wish to earn a Bachelors of Music at The Hartt School ("Hartt") of The University of Hartford, West Hartford, CT ("UHartford") (each individually, a "Party" and collectively, the "Parties"), takes effect on the last date signed below ("Effective Date").

#### **Background**

The Parties desire this Agreement to facilitate mutual understanding and allow a smoother transition for students from SCCC to Hartt.

#### The Agreement

The Parties agree as follows:

- I. Admission Criteria. Any transferring SCCC student ("Student") is guaranteed admission to Hartt if the Student has:
  - A. successfully earned an Associate of Science in Performing Arts Music degree at SCCC with a cumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher;
  - completed each applicable UHartford and Hartt application process including having:
    - submitted each required official transcript and other required supplemental material; and
    - met each applicable deadline as published on Hartt's website;
  - C. met each UHartford admission requirement; and
  - passed each applicable music audition and interview for entrance to Hartt.

### II. Hartt Program Requirements.

- A. <u>Placement</u>. A Student's opportunity to complete the Student's degree in two years at Hartt is conditional on the Student successfully completing an applicable level-placement audition and passing each relevant placement examination.
- B. <u>Duration</u>. Hartt requires each Music Education Student successfully to complete at least
   2.5 years of study at Hartt. This requirement includes four full time semesters of coursework and an additional semester of student teaching.

- C. <u>Transfer Credit</u>. The Student must have earned at least a "C-" grade in each course taken at SCCC for that course's class credit to successfully transfer to Hartt (see below for relevant information on grades for music education courses).
- III. Required SCCC Background. Each Student must take the following courses in choosing the Student's music electives at SCCC to ensure that the Student remains on track per the attached amendments.
  - A. <u>Music Education, Instrumental Concentration</u>.
    - Required SCCC Prerequisites. If a Student seeks a BMUS in Music Education, Instrumental Concentration, then that Student must earn at least a "B-" grade in each following course for transfer credit to be awarded):

MUS 283 - Music in Contemporary Ed I

MUS 284 - Music in Contemporary Ed II

MUS 157 - Conducting 1

MUS 158 - Conducting II

MUS 285 - Brass Techniques

MUS 286 - Woodwind Techniques

MUS 167 - Percussion Techniques

MUS 171- Beginning Voice Class

- 2. Recommended Choir Coursework. Hartt recommends that each Student who is pursuing Music Education, Instrumental Concentration should take two semesters of choir in addition to the Student's four semesters of instrumental ensemble.
- B. <u>Mathematics</u>. In choosing a math class to fulfill the requirements for SCCC's AS degree, Hartt recommends the following options:

MAT 147 - Statistics

MAT 167 - Precalculus with Analytic Geometry

MAT 180 - Calculus

### IV. General Requirements.

- A. <u>Substantial Changes</u>. Each Party must inform the other Party of each future change in the informing Party's degree requirements and NASM accreditation status that has an impact on the Agreement's programs, and provide updated transfer credit equivalencies for each affected course.
- B. <u>Promotion</u>. Each Party must encourage qualified students to participate in this arrangement and provide those students with appropriate information and advising throughout their time at SCCC.

- Term; Termination. This Agreement takes effect on Effective Date and remains in effect C. until terminated via written notice by either Party. A terminating Party must send that notice no later than six months before the date on which the termination takes effect.
- Binding Authority. By signing below, each Party: D.
  - acknowledges its acceptance of this Agreement's provision; and 1.
  - represents and warrants that it has authorized each respective signer to sign on 2. behalf of and to bind that Party to this Agreement as of the Effective Date.
