

Transfer Articulation Agreement Between Nazareth College of Rochester And Schenectady County Community College

This document establishes a formal transfer agreement between Nazareth College of Rochester and Schenectady County Community College.

Objectives

To enter into an agreement that will encourage and allow transfer of students from Schenectady County Community College in the following programs:

Schenectady County Community College A.S. in Performing Arts: Music	Nazareth College B.M. in Music Education – Choral Emphasis B.M. in Music Education – Band Emphasis
A.S. in Performing Arts: Music A.S. in Performing Arts: Music	B.M. in Music Education – Band Emphasis B.M. in Music Education – String Emphasis

The objectives of this agreement are:

- To promote an efficient transition of highly qualified transfer students from Schenectady County Community 1. College to Nazareth College of Rochester.
- To provide specific information for students who wish to transfer to Nazareth College of Rochester to pursue a 2. baccalaureate degree.
- To provide a clear and systematic procedure for the exchange of information relating to transfer from 3. Schenectady County Community College to Nazareth College of Rochester.

Full junior standing will be granted for transfer students in the following program:

Nazareth College of Rochester Bachelor of Music in Music Education - Choral Emphasis, Band or String

Emphasis

Terms

The conditions under which transfer will be accomplished include:

- 1. Students must successfully complete the Schenectady County Community College Associate in Science, Performing Arts: Music degree program before entering Nazareth College of Rochester Bachelor of Music in Music Education -Choral Emphasis, Band or String Emphasis program.
- 2. A Schenectady County Community College transfer student's ability to complete their degree at Nazareth College in 2 years is conditional on their passing their audition and placement exams for junior level placement at Nazareth College. Placement exams are given in music theory, music history and piano.

- 3. Students will follow the application procedure for transfer students as outlined in the Nazareth College of Rochester current undergraduate catalog. Transfer students must complete and file the Transfer Application for Undergraduate Admission prior to <u>April 1 for fall semester entry</u> and <u>November 1 for spring semester entry</u>.
- Students must maintain a satisfactory academic record at Schenectady County Community College, one indicating
 promise of completing Nazareth College of Bachelor of Music in Music Education Choral Emphasis, Band or String
 Emphasis program.
- 5. The record should include a minimum GPA of 2.7.
- 6. There is a 60 credit hour limit on the amount of eligible transfer credit granted.
- 7. Although transfer credit cannot be given for physical education courses, their successful completion at Schenectady County Community College fulfills the physical education requirements at Nazareth College of Rochester.
- 8. Courses with grades of "C" or better will be accepted for transfer credit.
- 9. For VPA agreements: Students are required to successfully complete an audition for admission to the Music Department. Please see the VPA Information website for more information.
- 10. The exact content of a student's degree program at Nazareth College of Rochester will depend upon the specific courses taken as part of the Schenectady County Community College Associate in Science, Performing Arts: Music program. Those students who anticipate transfer to Nazareth College of Rochester should seek advisement from their Schenectady County Community College faculty advisor or The Center for Advisement in determining which courses will best satisfy the degree requirements at Nazareth College of Rochester.
- 11. The attached addendum (Addendum A) includes a semester-by-semester advising guide to complete the Associate in Science, Performing Arts: Music program at Schenectady County Community College and Bachelor of Music in Music Education Choral Emphasis, Band or String Emphasis program at Nazareth College of Rochester.

 Addendum B includes an articulation agreement chart indicating which Schenectady County Community College courses will satisfy Nazareth College of Rochester core and major requirements.

Other Programs

Transfer opportunities may exist in programs not listed in the agreement. Students enrolled in those programs who have an interest in transfer are encouraged to apply. These applications will be handled on an individual basis.

Review and Revision

- 1. This agreement will be reviewed every three years or when substantial changes are made in the curriculum on either campus. At the request of either party, a review of the Transfer Articulation Agreement will be conducted by both institutions. The course selection included in this articulation may be subject to change as new requirements are established for majors. Both institutions assume a good faith effort to continually update each college on any changes to programs and requirements. This joint effort on the part of both institutions is to help transfer students maximize their transferability.
- Nazareth College of Rochester agrees to regularly inform Schenectady County Community College of the progress of its graduates who transfer under the auspices of the Transfer Articulation Agreement.
