VIOLONCELLO CONCENTRATION

First Year Students

Goals are to establish a solid foundation of cello technique and to develop the art of music making through emphasis on intonation, quality of tone, technical facility, music reading (tenor clef) and musicality. Further exercises for vibrato and expansion of range will be included.

Second Year Students

By the end of the second year, the student should play with good intonation, natural tone production, have developed an articulated left-hand, posses and expressive vibrato and have proficiency in tenor and treble clef reading and playing.

One assigned etude; scale and arpeggios. The scale will be drawn the day of the jury. Memorization is expected. Two contrasting pieces or movements from sonatas, concertos or Bach solo suites.
