Phlebotomy Technician Course

Phlebotomists are health care professionals who draw blood and other specimens from patients or blood donors for medical testing and processing. This certificate program prepares professionals to collect blood specimens from clients for the purpose of laboratory analysis. Phlebotomists must have excellent attention to detail. Making sure that each test sample is labeled correctly is extremely vital if the right test is to be performed on the patient's blood. Phlebotomists draw blood from arteries and veins in order to get samples.

COURSE LEARNING OUTCOMES

Students will become familiar with all aspects related to blood collection and develop comprehensive skills to perform venipunctures completely and safely. Classroom and lab work includes terminology, anatomy and physiology; blood collection procedures; specimen hands-on practice, training in skills and techniques to perform puncture methods and focus on safety standards. After 93 hours of academic and lab work, students must complete a minimum of 40 hours or 100 successful venipunctures during an internship at a local hospital. At the end of course and internship students will sit for the National Health Career Association (NHA) examination.
